- Seasonal events including a Christmas party



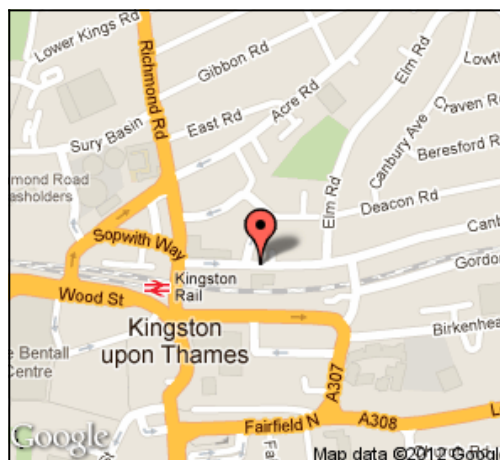
